

All of the spaces located at the edge of the exterior walls of the building have windows facing the exterior (daylight). It's not possible to hand on your exterior walls in the ground floor.





THE PLACE : motoco

Motoco takes place in an industrial building (building 75), almost 9000m², located in the heart of an industrial site in complete renewal in Mulhouse. Motoco is a working place, an artistic, cultural and multidisciplinary space, with almost 140 resident artists and craftspeople, who experiment every day new ways of living their creative activity, by pooling tools, knowledge, materiel resources or humans, in the collective interest.


By advocating artistic eclecticism and the diversity of audiences, motoco provides their resident with private workshops at very reduces prices and shared spaces and tools for creation and conviviality. Space of social, artiste, cultural, economic and unique urban experiences in Alsace, motoco is a community that ventures into new forms of expression and collaboration, choosing openness and diversity rather than withdrawal.


Involved in support and development of artistic and creative activities for the common good, heritage conservation and transformation of industrial wasteland, motoco wants to develop the partnerships established for nearly 3 years, to perpetuate its action in favor of the territory, and to place sustainably this site as reference in the economic, cultural and identity cooperation of the south Alsace, at the heart of the three border region and of Europe.

Motoco hosts a dozen nationalities (30% of foreigners), an incubator managed by the HEAR (Haute Ecole des Arts du Rhin), foreign residents managed by the Kunsthalle (art center of Mulhouse), an image pole, a screen printing pole, a carpentry area and two large spaces for events.

The building 75, which houses the motoco project, has three floors with different activities:

- Ground floor : two rooms for events (capacity of 1200 people) and image and screen printing poles
- First and second floor : 92 workshops from 10 to 200m²
